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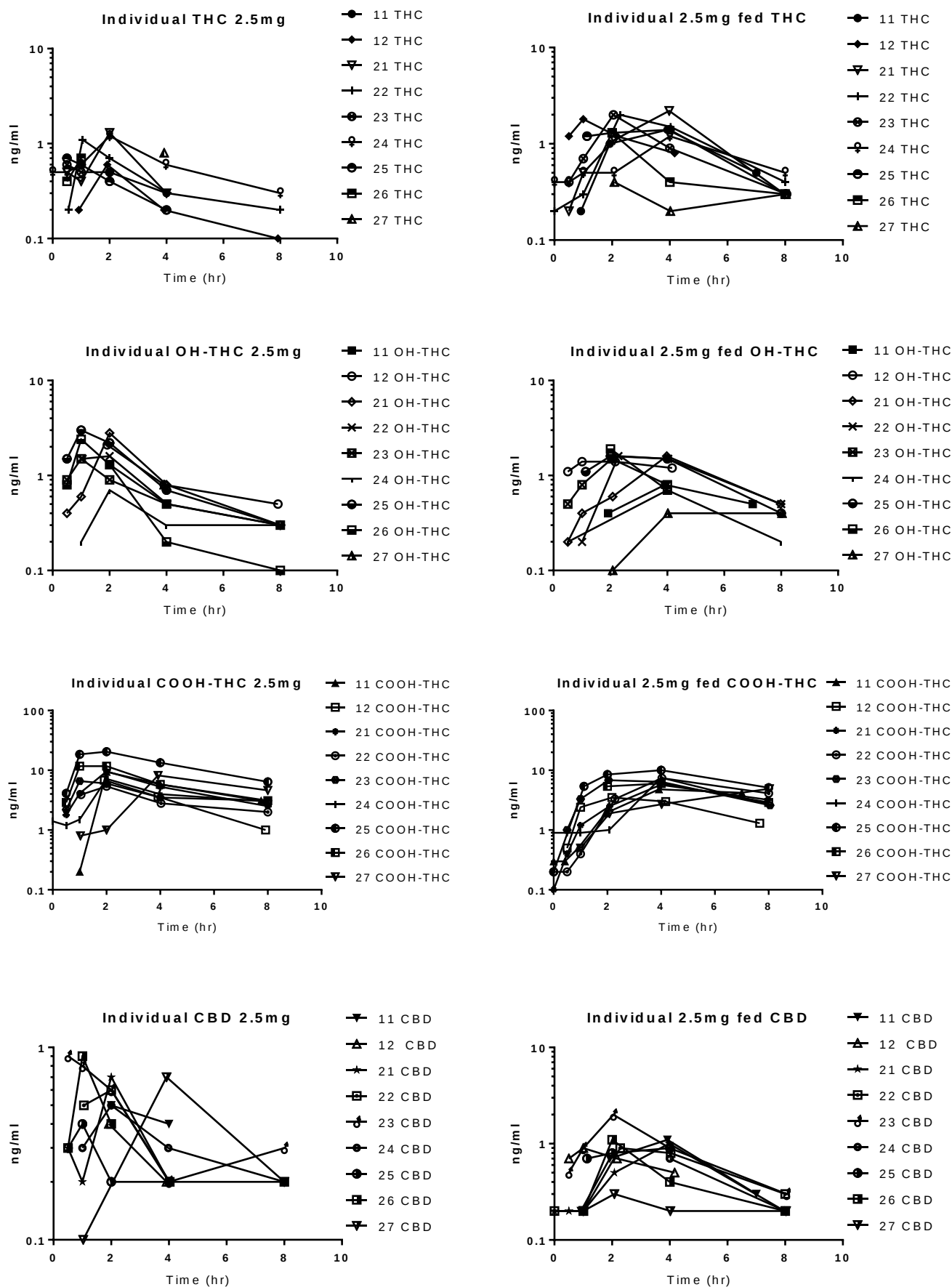
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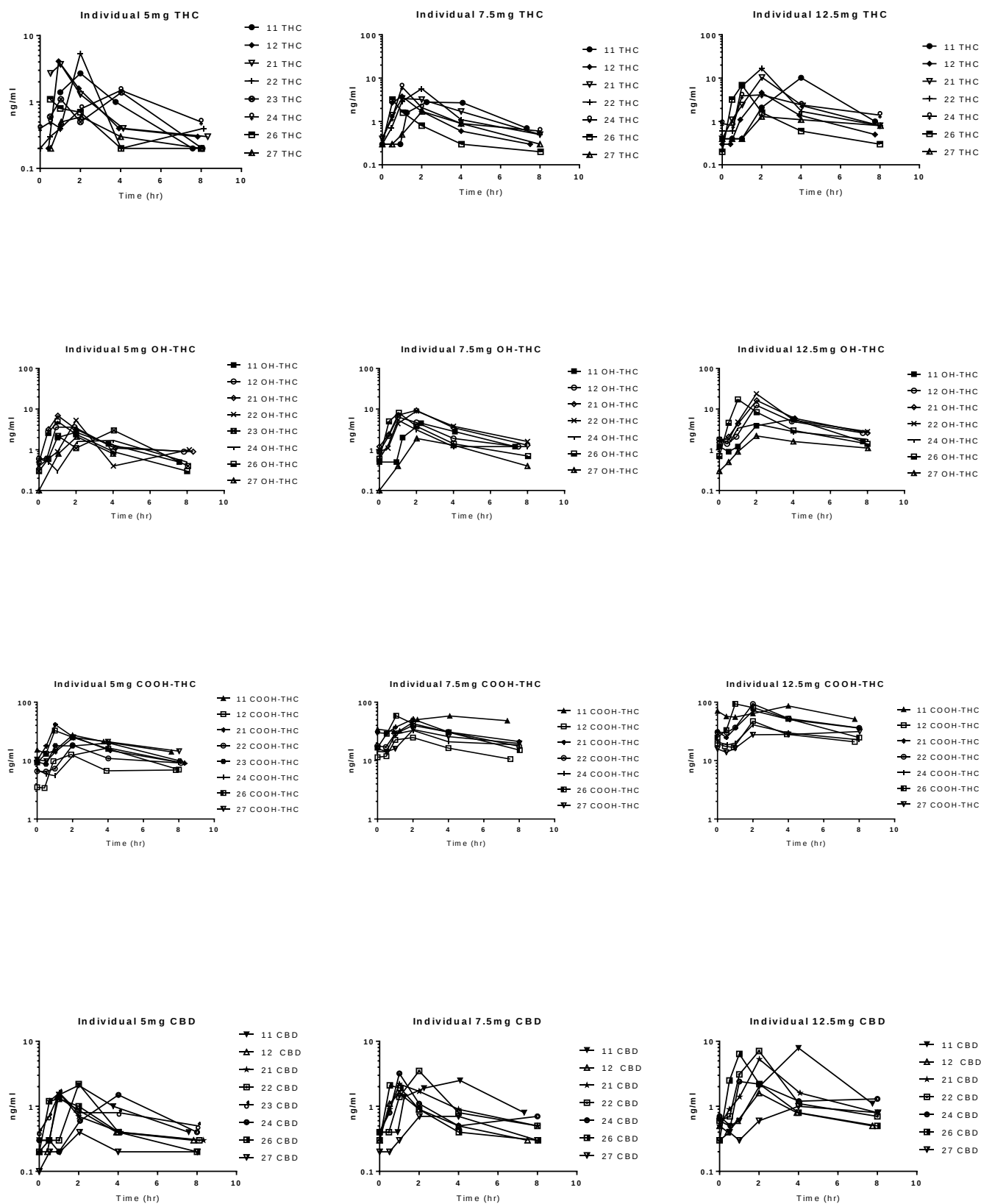
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Supplementary Information Figure 1a. Individual concentration time curves at all doses



Supplementary Information Figure 1b. Individual concentration time curves at all doses

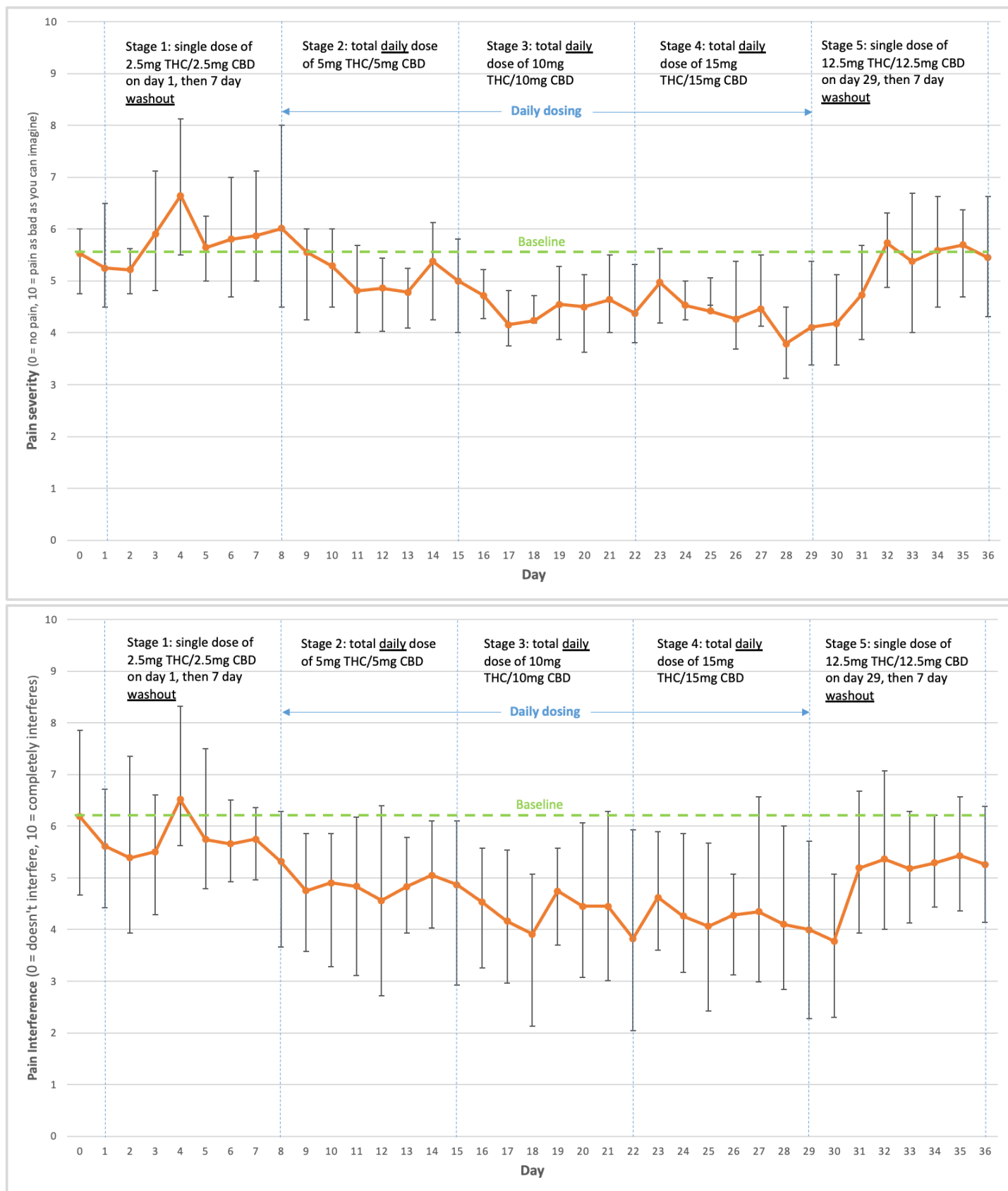


Figure 2: Brief Pain Inventory (Severity and interference scores) by day at each dose (Mean)



Figure 3: Depression, Anxiety and Stress Score (DASS21) by day at each dose (Mean)

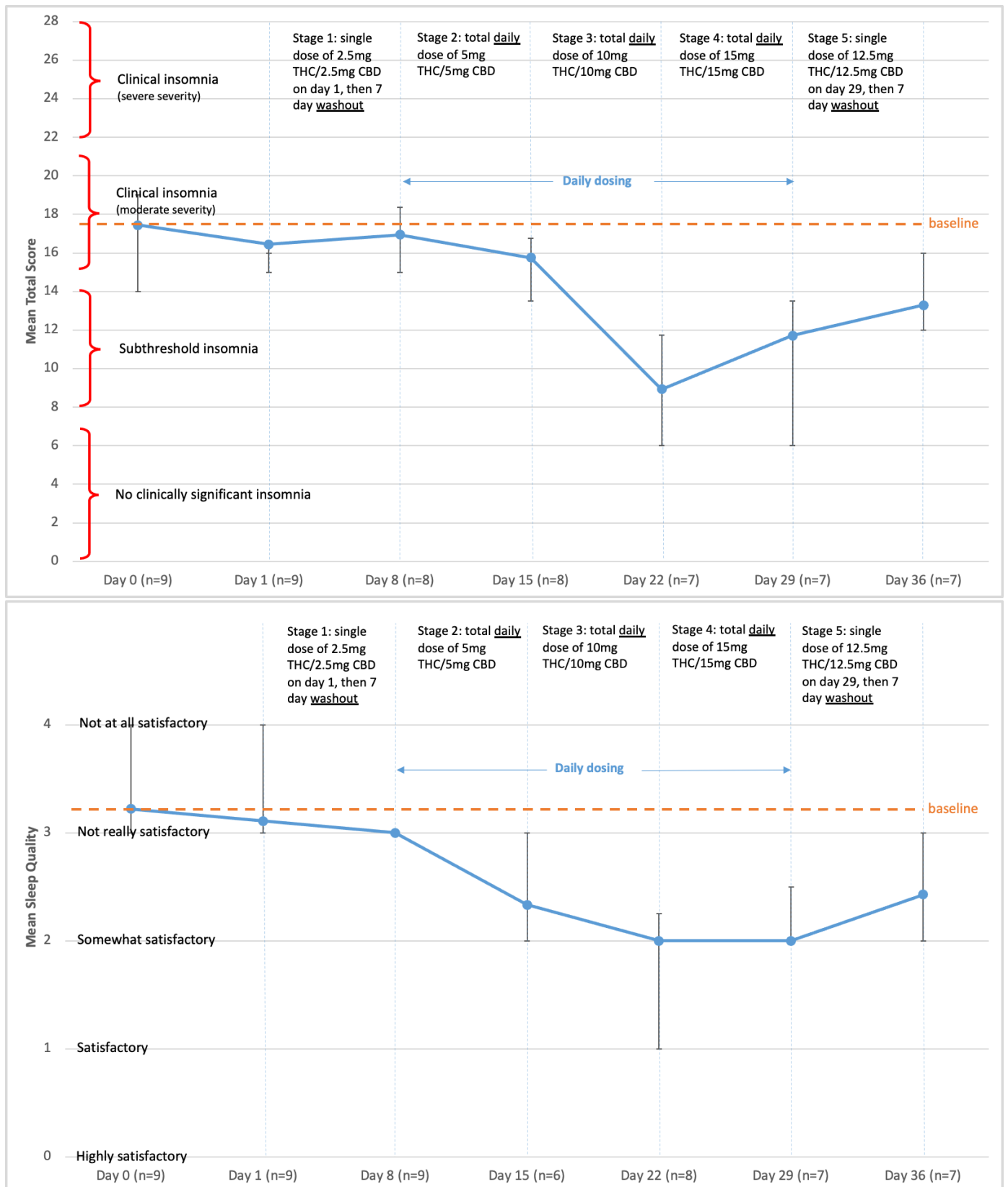


Figure 4: Insomnia Scale (ISI) by day at each dose (Mean)
