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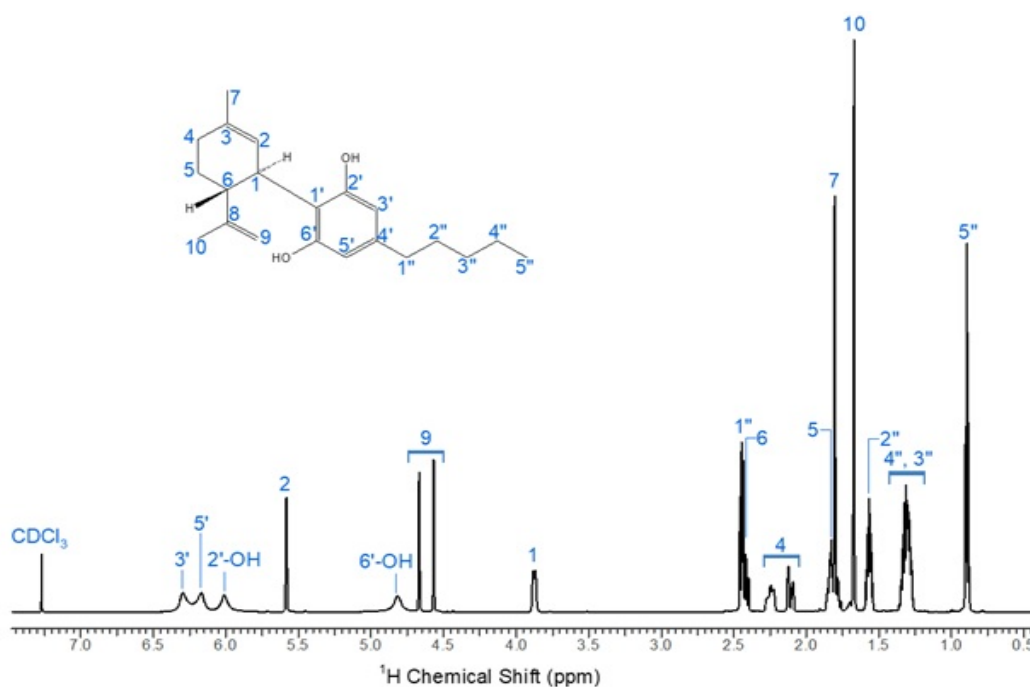


Figure S1. ¹H NMR spectrum of CBD in Chloroform - d

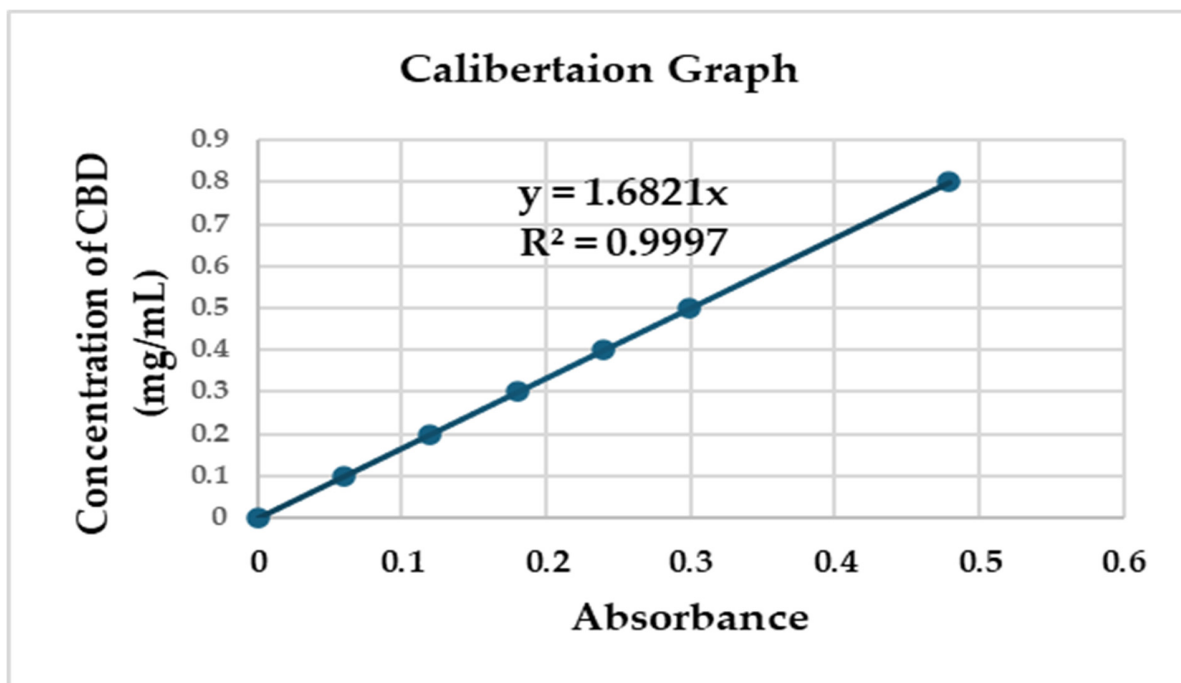


Figure S2. Calibration graph of CBD Concentration versus Absorbance
